- Paralyzed 87-year old Daw Than Kyi burnt to death in her own house

SUMMARY OF THE INCIDENT

12th July 2022 (Tuesday evening)

After encountering the local People Defence Forces (LPDFs) near Ye U Township, Mee Maung Gone Village, Sagaing Region, around 100 military troops, divided as 4 groups, surrounded the village from all sides and invaded the village. Then the military troops starting firing heavy artilleries and setting some houses on fire. They deployed at the village that night, taking and consuming 5 goats and chickens from the local farms and stealing the properties of the local villagers from the nearby houses.

13th July 2022 (morning)

The military council troops left the village. Before leaving, a total of 80 out of 200 houses was set on fire.

An 87-year old disabled woman named Daw Than Kyi was burnt and killed in her own house.

A lot of inch-size cartridge cells used by the them were found in the village after they left.
