




These presentations are references from the direct interviews of KNDF and DMO PDF, RFA, The Irrawaddy.

Military terrorists used heavy weapons to launch attacks near Nam Nain Village in Pin Laung township, Shan State. Three monks and nineteen civilians were massacred after being arrested

March 11, 2023



Date & Time - 2023, March 11, 11:00 am

Perpetrator - Brigadier General Nay Lin Aung, the commander of the No. (7) Operation Command Headquarter (SKA-7) based in Pekon Township ,
General Myo Min Tun, the commander of the Eastern Military Command based in Taunggyi City

Summary of Incident

Troops - about 200

Incident - Burnt down 10 civilians' houses

Past Incident - Last 2 weeks ago, Burnt down fifty civilian houses in the Nam Nain village,
one resident had been killed with the heavy weapons attack

Summary of Incident

- ❑ **2023, 11 March, 16:00 - military terrorists used aircraft and heavy weapons to attack the area around Nam Nain village and the civilians of Nam Nain village fled and hid in the village's monastery**
- ❑ **military terrorist group raided the village and forcibly removed the Buddhist monks and civilians from their hiding place and then brutally killed in front of the monastery wall**



died around the temple with gunshot wounds and knife wounds on their heads

Killed by MA1 gunshot and knife

22 people (including 3 monks) are killed in this case

Monk - 3

People - 19 (Female -1, Male - 18)

Motorcycles in the Monastery compound were burnt down by military junta

Additional facts...

- ❑ Military terrorist group has intensified their attacks on four fronts: Pin Laung township, Shar Taw township, Demoso township, and Bawlake township, with a total of 12 battle columns.
- ❑ Because of the fierce attacks, the residents of Nam Nain village fled to other areas.
