

Battalion (317) of Division (88) under the Terrorist Military Council committed brutal acts

In the incident, the terrorist group that came to Bamaw Township from Katha Township in Sagaing Region, they entered the village by firing heavy weapons from warships into Toatgyi village in Katha Township, burning 45 homes and killing seven people.

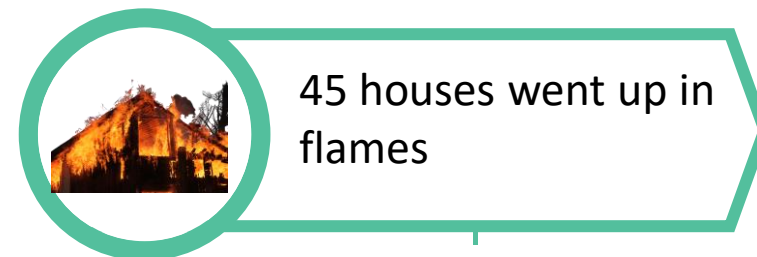
It was presented by the Ministry of Human Rights.



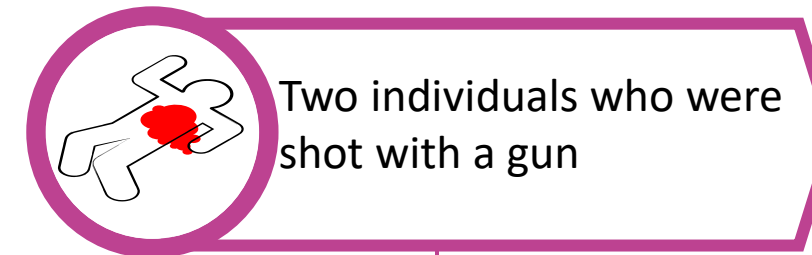
# A brief description of the process



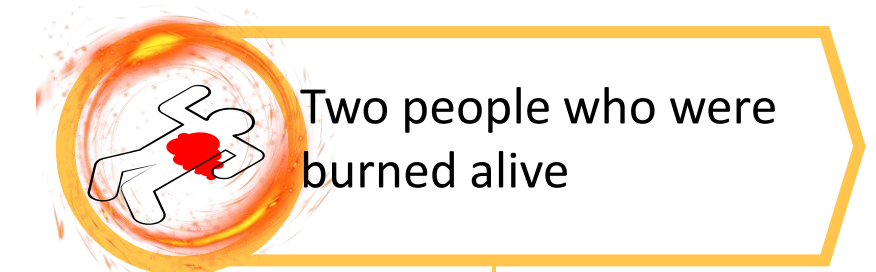
-On September 17<sup>th</sup>, Battalion (317) of division (88) came with 6 warships from Kathar to Bamaw along the Irrawaddy River at around 9 a.m. and fought with PDF.  
-After the terrorist military force opened fire with heavy weapons on Toatgyi village and anchored the warship, around 15 military armed troops entered the village



-At 12:23 p.m., they started burning Toatgyi village; 45 houses were destroyed, and those who fled were brutally slaughtered and set on fire



-Killed the villager Ko Ye Maung with a gun and set fire to his house. When the military force retreated, the villagers arrived in time and did not set fire to the body.  
-Villager Ko Nyan Tun (@) Ko Kite Kite was shot and killed by a gun and died from a 4-inch puncture wound beneath his left chin

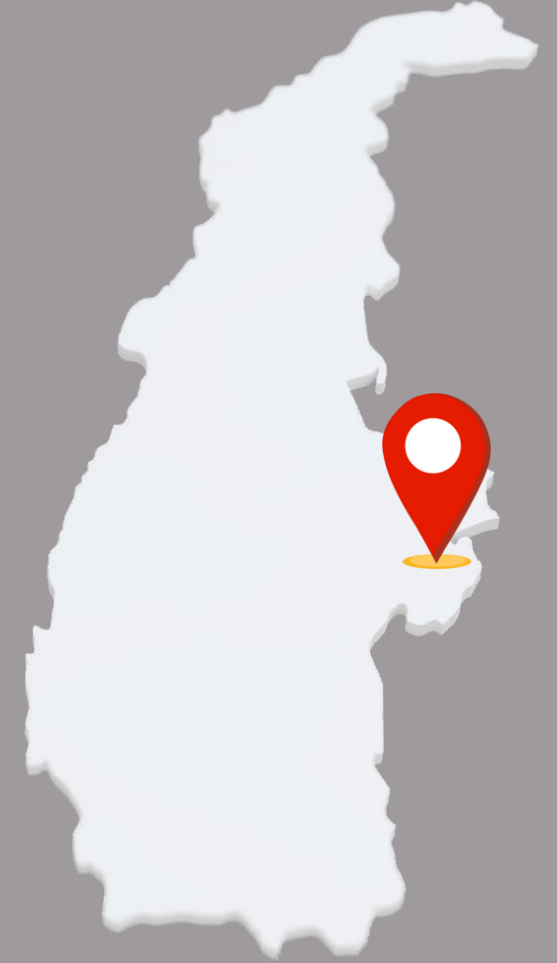


-Villagers U Aung Lin and U Khin Maung Htay (presumed to be) were burned alive in a building near the old school; two were separated by two feet burned alive.  
-Three villagers are still missing as no bodies have been recovered.
