



A terrorist military junta's forces arrested seven villagers fleeing the war, including women, persons with disabilities, and children, and massacred six of them at Hsusi Village in Shadaw Township (South) of Karenni State.

The brief process of the incident

On the evening of February 4th

The terrorist military junta's forces, consisting of about 60 members, patrolled the column in Shadaw Township and arrested seven villagers fleeing the war with handcuffs, tied together to a rope. Among those arrested were men, pregnant women, including people with disabilities, and children. There were seven casualties in total, including two pairs of mother and son, as well as a grandmother and her granddaughter.

On February 5th, about 9:00 a.m.

Those who had been arrested were found massacred somewhere in the forest. Even though one of the kids was still breathing and made an effort to receive medical treatment, his gunshot wound was too severe, and he died en route to nearby medical unit.

One of the arrested managed to escape handcuffed. According to the testimony of the survivor, the victims were shot on orders from the battalion commander of the terrorist military junta's forces, LIB-249.
