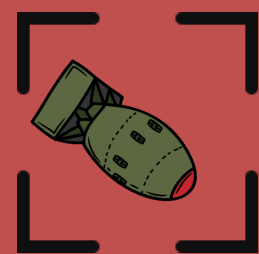
Brief process of the incident

On September 5th, at 9:45 p.m., near Laei Village in Pekon Township, Southern Shan State, the terrorist military junta launched an airstrike with two jet fighters from Taungoo air base, dropping **three 500-pound bombs** on IDPs in Bangkok Village within the space of two minutes.

DUE TO THE ATTACK IN WHICH THREE BOMBS WERE DROPPED,

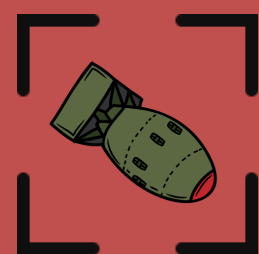


About 20 homes were damaged in all, and many people were injured.



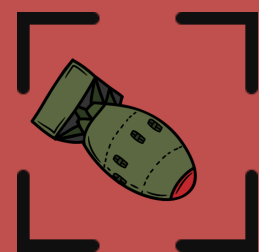
The first one

The explosion detonated about 20 feet away from the place where the refugees lived.



The second one

A bomb exploded in a bomb shelter inside IDPs, killing all six members of the family.



The final one

As the explosion hit the middle of the IDP camp, 3 more civilians were killed, bringing a total to 9 deaths.

Damages

The victims included **six children under age and three women**, and **most of their bodies were shattered**.

The information received is up to date as of September 7 in the afternoon. The testimony of eyewitnesses on the ground provides data.



Status of airstrike fatalities



Male- 3

Female- 6



The three males who died were 3, 8, and 11-year-old children

Six females died, including children ages 11, 13, and 16.

Additional circumstances

The bombing terrified civilians and injured victims in Bangkok's IDP camp, forcing them to flee.
